



Fire & Risk Management

“Fire safety is only one of many safety issues with which management must concern themselves to minimise the risk of injury or death of their staff or members of the public. Unlike most of the other safety concerns, fire has the potential to injure or kill large numbers of people very quickly. The law requires employers to ensure the workplace is safe from fire and its effects.”

Do you comply with fire legislation?

Here is a simple way to check if you are currently complying with the requirements of fire legislation.

You must as an employer or landlord: -

- Carry out a fire-risk assessment identifying any possible dangers and risks.
- Consider who may be specifically at risk.
- Remove or reduce the risk of fire as far as is reasonably practicable and provide general fire precautions to deal with any residual risk.
- Take other appropriate measures to ensure there is protection if flammable or explosive materials are used or stored.
- Develop a plan to deal with any emergency and, in most cases, keep a record of your findings.
- Undertake a review of your findings when necessary.

- Make recommendations on the improvements required to increase fire safety and awareness.
- Ensure your fire safety measures are adequate for the number of employees on site.
- Prepare emergency plans, and provide training to your employees in fire precautions and emergency procedures.
- Develop systems for testing that the measures you have in place are regularly monitored and sufficient.
- Review or update your risk assessment if the situation changes or as a matter of best practice.
